<p>ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO ESTABLISH CLAIMS ADMINISTRATION PROCEDURE AND TO SET CLAIMS BAR DATE</p>	

THIS MATTER is before the Court on the Motion to Establish Claims Administration Procedure and to Set Claims Bar Date (the "Motion"), filed by C. Randel Lewis, in his capacity as the receiver (the "Receiver"), for Mueller Capital Management, LLC and Mueller Over Under Fund, LP. The Court has reviewed the Receiver's Motion and the file. Good cause exists for the establishment of a claims procedure and a claims bar date. It is therefore

ORDERED that the Receiver's Motion is GRANTED;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Claim Form and Notice attached to the Motion are APPROVED;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties asserting claims against Mueller Capital Management, LLC, Mueller Over Under Fund, LP, or the receivership Estate shall submit claims to the Receiver on or before **November 30, 2010**;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Receiver shall promptly provide the Notice to all known creditors and parties in interest as set forth in the Motion, publish the form of Notice in the Denver Post, and shall file a certificate of service reflecting the same;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, for any unknown claimant not receiving Notice of the claims bar date within time sufficient to file a claim by November 30, 2010, the Receiver shall mail the Notice and Claim Form promptly upon discovering any further claimant and shall file an additional certificate of service. Such claimant shall then have a period of forty-five (45) days from the Receiver's mailing within which to submit a claim to the Receiver in accordance with the procedures approved herein.
